Grantmaking

In 2010, three large-scale community collaboration initiatives were funded for three years at \$225,000 each. The grants involve over 30 nonprofit organizations and seek to build the capacity of nonprofits to address major community issues more effectively.

Santa Cruz Community Foundation, an affiliate of the Community Foundation for Southern Arizona, provides community leadership, grants, scholarships and raises awareness of the U.S./Mexico border needs.
